CLOSING DATE FOR AUT SECONDARY SCHOOLS SCHOLARSHIPS: 01 September 2013

AUT in recognition of its partnership with selected secondary schools in the Auckland region¹ has established undergraduate scholarships to reward academic excellence.

Only **one** Vice-Chancellor nomination per school - to be selected by the school.

¹Appendix 1: Eligible Schools

AMOUNT OF AWARD

This scholarship will cover:

- Tuition fees for a maximum of four papers per semester
- All other fees, including the Learner Services Levy and Student's Association fee are not covered and will need to be met by the student.
- This scholarship does not cover failed papers and any Summer School papers.

TENURE

- This scholarship is awarded for a maximum of three years subject to the student annually meeting the conditions of renewal.

CRITERIA

All students nominated for this scholarship must be:

- NZ Citizens or permanent residents
- Nominated by a secondary school that is in the Auckland region.

It is expected that the applicant will have as a minimum, one of the following:

- NCEA 240 rank score *
- CIE 200 rank score *
- IB Principal's predicted score 31

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE AND RENEWAL

- The award of this scholarship is conditional on the student gaining entry to an AUT undergraduate degree programme.
- Recipients must be enrolling for the first time, in a full-time programme of study.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
- The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Scholarships Office
- Annual renewal of the scholarship is conditional upon the student attaining a **B grade average** and meeting the requirements listed below:
 - Students will be required to negotiate regular contact with their designated AUT Student Services support centre staff. This is an integral part of the first year and may be extended for subsequent years.
- The Scholarship Office has the power to terminate or suspend a scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a recipient from the Programme Leader of the programme in which they are enrolled.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship Application forms will be sent to eligible schools in June.
- Open June 10th 2013.
